St. John's High School Ministry:

This is a break down for the High School programs (HSM) at St. John's.

Bible Study:

The primary purpose for HSM is fellowship. Our main goal for HSM is that there is a place where students can connect with one another and adults in a safe place and maintain meaningful relationships.

The secondary purpose for HSM is discipleship. Every week we will study and discuss Christian teachings from various curriculums. A portion of the small group time will be devoted to the application of biblical truths to our lives. HSM is not place where we sit and strictly learn, nor is a time where we have social hour. HSM is a place for students to form relationships: with others and with God.

We meet every Tuesday starting September 13th from 7:00pm-9:00pm in the Ministry House, [*enter through the black gate in the back parking lot*]. If you have any question please contact Dave at 925-7756 ext 243

Outreach In The Community:

Our focus for the students will is about all about getting out into the community and helping others. By learning the student's gifts and talents, we will expose them to many different activities that focus on those areas so they can get involved in sharing the gospel through action and word. Learning about God is only part of the process in growing in a relationship with the creator of the universe. The other part is living out his teachings and passing them on to others around us.

Planned Vision:

Our vision is to ultimately move students from a life without Christ to having a life with Him and move them to having a spiritual walk on their own and not be dependent on programs or people.

Student Ministry Purpose Statement:

Our Student Ministry exists to **ILLUSTRATE** God's love to students, help them **INITIATE** a genuine relationship with Jesus Christ and other believers, help them **IDENTIFY** God's purpose for their lives, **INVOLVE** them in the work in the ministry and **IDOLIZE** God with their life.

Student Ministry Policies:

Cell Phones:

We know how much cell phones play a role in the day-to-day lives of kids and adults. During youth group, cell phones will be allowed at the beginning of the meeting. Once we start worshiping and getting into the Word, kids will be asked to put their cell phones away.

If there is a problem with the cell phone at any time (i.e. misbehaving with it, taking it out after being talked too, etc) we will take it away and it will be given back at the end of the bible study.

Behavior:

At St. John's Student Ministries, when we discipline students we are not hurting them but helping them understand respect for others and for themselves.

If a student is having a behavior issue we will first address it with the student and resolve it. If the issue continues we will let the parents know so that we can work with the parent to resolve any issues. Sometimes continued issues can mean that there are deeper issues taking place and we want to work with the student and parent to help during these times.

What We Don't Want To See:

- PDA (Public Display of Affection)
- Foul Language
- Poor attitude
- Disrespect of property
- Making negative remarks to or about others
- Being loud, talking or being a distraction during worship/message

Other Discipline Problems:

- Students who drink, smoke, bring medications (unless there is a doctors note, in that case adult leaders must be notified) of any kind before/during/after the time of youth will have parents called immediately and suspended for a time that is fitting to the situation.
- Fighting results in automatic suspension for a month. Parents and students must meet with the Youth Director before they are allowed back to youth group.
- Any inappropriate items brought on or to Church grounds (Weapons, Lighters, etc.) will be confiscated immediately and **returned when the parent comes to pick up. If parent is not present, they will pick it up from the Youth Directors Office during the week.**
- Any improper dress that is revealing, using negative wording/profanity or inappropriate pictures will either be asked to turn clothing in-side out or go home and change.

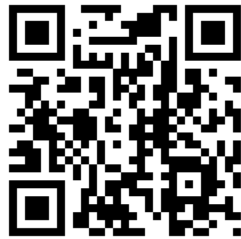
